Hospice News: Consult Billing, Coding Details For COVID-19 Vaccinations As Rollout Continues

The path to COVID-19 vaccination is paved with technical details, including some new ones from Medicare.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has posted documents explaining the developing coding structure for vaccinations, billing details, and more.

For example: "Medicare payment rates for COVID-19 vaccine administration will be \$28.39 to administer single-dose vaccines," CMS explains on its COVID-19 vaccination payment webpage. "For a COVID-19 vaccine requiring a series of 2 or more doses, the initial dose(s) administration payment rate will be \$16.94, and \$28.39 for the administration of the final dose in the series."

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The vaccine itself is being distributed for free by the federal government, CMS adds.
