Hospice News: Watch For Updated List Of MA Plans In Hospice Carve-In

Plus: GAO keeps an eye on MA disenrollments at end of life.

As the Medicare Advantage carve-in of hospice patients proceeds, a data point from a recent Government Accountability Office report on MA plan disenrollment may give some context to the issue.

In 2015, the percent of MA plan enrollees who disenrolled from the plan in their last year of life and used hospice was 3.0 percent. The figure was almost the same for 2016 at 3.1 percent, the GAO notes in its report, Beneficiary Disenrollments to Fee-for-Service in Last Year of Life Increase Medicare Spending. Those figures crept up to 4.7 and 4.8 percent in 2017 and 2018, the GAO found.
