Test Yourself: What You Don't Know Can Hurt Your Surgical Wound Care Coding and RUG Scores

1. Which of the following constitutes surgical wound care for purposes of coding it in Section M of the MDS 2.0 or MDS 3.0? Circle all that apply.

- 1. Topical cleansing and/or wound irrigation
- 2. Application of antimicrobial ointments
- 3. Application of dressings of any type
- 4. Suture/staple removal
- 5. Warm soaks or heat application
- 6. Application of medicated eye patches after ocular surgery
- 7. Wound care following surgical debridement of a pressure ulcer

2. A surgical wound and one or more skin treatments coded on the MDS 2.0 may place the resident into which of the following RUG-III categories, if he or she has the requisite ADL score:
