Answer: For the CPPM® exam, you should look at the who, what, when, where and why of the exam. Check out this info on CPPM® certifications, and why you might consider getting it:

Who? The American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC) administers the Certified Physician Practice Manager (CPPM®) exam.

What? According to the AAPC, a CPPM® certification will demonstrate that you have expertise in:

- The workings of different insurance plans;
- The processes, workflow and reform of the healthcare business;
- Where fraud, abuse can occur;
- Corporate compliance;
- What constitutes quality healthcare;
- Accounting, physician reimbursement, and medical practice revenue cycle management;
- Human resource management;
- Forming relationships with marketing and business partners;
- Securing data, specifically protected health information (PHI), for compliance with the Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act (HIPAA) and
- Health information technology (IT), electronic health records (EHRs) and the health information exchange.

Where? On the aforementioned website, you can search for an exam by either:

- Country, state, or index or
- Country, zip code, and proximity.
