Compliance Alerts as a Method of Providing Guidance to Medicaid Providers

New York State Social Services Law Section 363-d requires the Office of the Medicaid Inspector General (OMIG) to create and make guidance available on its Web site to reflect the requirements of mandatory provider compliance programs. OMIG uses Compliance Alerts as a method to provide guidance to Medicaid providers in their efforts to adopt and implement effective compliance programs. The purpose of Compliance Alerts is to provide advice and guidance.

Compliance Alerts are intended to be published on a periodic basis. They will be posted on the OMIG Web site at www.omig.ny.gov.
